Each "H" signifies one sound associated with laughing — "hah," "hee", or "ho." A dot is a beat of silence.

Group 1 chooses the first sound; others use that sound when they join in. Any group may, during the first line, speed up, change sounds, add movements.

Stop just before the piece is in danger of falling apart. Then everyone can have a good laugh.
